that the gross value of the said estate in Great Britain

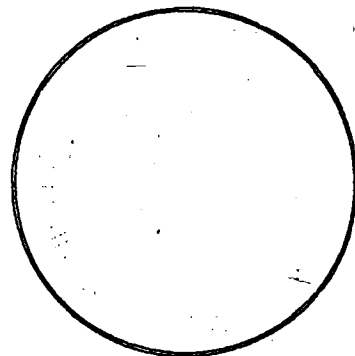
(exclusive of what the said deceased may have been possessed of or entitled
